

APPLICATION TO FILL VACANT OXDRIFT ELECTORIAL DISTRICT POSITION ON KDSB

The District of Kenora Unincorporated Areas Ratepayers Association is looking for an individual to fill a vacant position on the local Kenora District Services Board. Such individual will be responsible for representing the residents of the Unincorporated Area within the Kenora District of Ontario, know locally as “OXDRIFT”.

The selected individual will be appointed to the Services Board for the balance of the current term, namely thru to December 31st, 2014.

Duties of the successful individual will involve attending approximately eight meetings, annually, of the Kenora District Services Board, usually held mid week in Dryden. Depending on whether or not the individual participates in any Services Board committees, additional meeting attendance may be required.

The successful candidate will receive an annual salary of \$1,000.00 for this position, and in addition, will be paid \$110 per day while attending meetings, plus travel expenses, if any.

In addition to their activities on the Services Board, the successful applicant will become a member of the board of directors of DOKURA. This position is a voluntary position with the only remuneration being expenses, if any. This board meets approximately four times annually, alternating between Kenora, Vermillion Bay and Dryden.

To be eligible for this position, the successful individual must be a Canadian citizen, age 18 or over and a permanent resident of the Oxdrift District. The Oxdrift Electoral District covers an area bounded on the west by Bridges Township, on the south by the Rainy River District, on the east by the Thunder Bay District and on the north by an east west line drawn just north of Sioux Lookout. The municipal areas within the district are excluded.

The selection process involves interested individuals making written application to the District of Kenora Unincorporated Areas Ratepayers Association – DoKURA. The Directors of DoKURA, excluding any who may make application for the vacant position, will then meet, review the applications, and select one individual. Their selection will be reported to the Kenora District Services Board who will make the formal appointment at their next meeting – January 2012.
